### C. International transfer of information

The KAVX websites can be accessed from anywhere in the world. Accordingly, KAVX cannot control the transfer of data from such location to the website itself and cannot assure that the transmission of such data is secure. Once the website has collected information, further transfer may be international depending on the nature of the information. **a. Right to access**

You have the right to obtain information about why your personal information is being processed, what categories of recipients may receive your personal information under Article 15 of the General Data Protection Regulation.<sup>8</sup>

More specifically, you have the right to confirm that we are processing your personal data. If we are, you have the right to obtain access to personal data.
